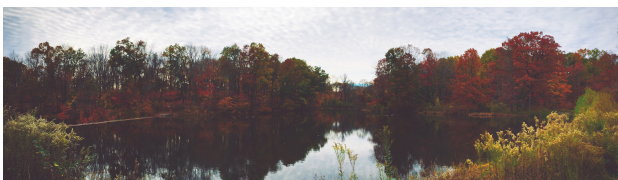

# ACCESS CONTROL



## What is access control?

Access control is a security system that restricts entry points to regulate people, vehicles, and goods. Access control can be monitored using physical security and/or self-service systems that ensure only authorized people enter the premises. This is done by showcasing identification, cards, keys, or biometric identifiers (such as fingerprints).

## Who is using it?

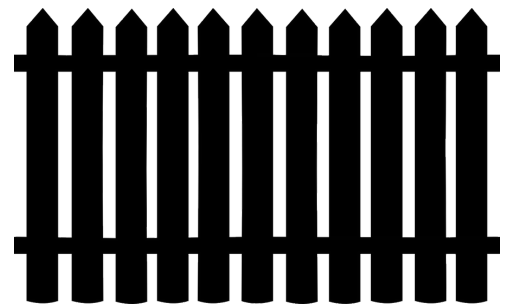
Access control has been implemented in office buildings, high-rise buildings,

schools, residential communities, government facilities, entertainment studio facilities. The goal of using Access Control is to create a safe and regulated space for residents, workers and visitors.

## Why is Access Control being used?

- Better control of incoming/outgoing people, vehicles, goods
- Alarm capacity
- Identify suspects earlier/delay assailants
- Prevents intruders
- Deter criminal activity

- Increases feeling of safety
- Ability to admit and monitor visitors remotely
- Integrates with other security systems (i.e. automatically lock doors in case of intruder).
